### Facility:

- If you are feeling sick, or have been in contact with a confirmed COVID-19 case, please stay home and do not come to the YMCA.
- Locker Rooms and showers will open July 1.
  - Sauna and Steam Rooms will remain closed
- Basketball; players must bring own equipment and no pick-up ball outside of family
- Racquetball; must bring own equipment and limited to two players
- In July, Day Passes will be sold to those residing in nearby areas of Cerro Gordo County, Floyd County, Mitchel County and Worth County only, at first
- Hours and Days are back to normal. The Y is closed 4th of July.
- Members entering High School or older are allowed at the Y alone, our younger members must be with a guardian while at the Y

### Pools:

- Aquatic Classes start July 1, registration is open but space is limited
- Lap Lane reservations will continue
- Therapy Pool reservations will begin for adults beginning July 1
- Hot Tub will remain closed

### Group Exercise:

- Open for non-members to register for classes

- A few more classes plan to start in August
- Restrictions of fans in room will continue through COVID-19
