POSITION SUMMARY:

The Day Camp Counselor is responsible for leading and supervising a group of school aged youth with and without disabilities in youth recreation activities and encourage character development, skill advancement, and safety.

1. Supervise and lead children with and without disabilities in the Day Camp program and maintain a fun, energetic, and positive environment.
2. Ensure safe practices by participants at all times, including sign in and sign out procedures.
3. At all times, model, reinforce, and abide by the YMCA core values of Caring, Honesty, Respect, and Responsibility and the Mason City Family YMCA Code of Conduct.
4. Maintain the cleanliness and safety of equipment and program area.
5. Manage and handle participant disputes.
6. Assist with Day Camp program design and activity plan.
7. Communicate with volunteers, staff, participants, and parents.
8. Attend regular staff meetings and trainings as requested.
